Evangelism (Kingdom)3**

- The Book of Acts (Acts of the Apostles) was very focused on the Power of the Holy Spirit and accomplishing the purposes of the Lord!
- Tool for studying the scriptures:
 - Read each chapter in light of the 5W's and H.
 - What happens in the chapter?
 - Where and when did it happen?
 - Who is involved or affected?
 - What is the result?
 - How does it happen (how are things done or said)?
 - Mark each reference to the Holy Spirit and then list what you learn about the Holy Spirit, his ministry, and the results. If a message is proclaimed in this chapter you may want to write the main points of the message and the effect of the message on those who hear it.
- Acts 10:1-8 God Prepares the Heart
 - **We must know and believe that God goes before us preparing the hearts of the lost for the gospel.**

- **Acts 10:9-23** - At the same time God is preparing the heart the lost to accept the gospel He is preparing the heart of Peter to present the Gospel:
- If we are going to spread the gospel will need to pray.
- **Acts 10:23-33** - Obedience to the Lord's Leading
 - Obedience may just be one of the hardest things we do, because it often requires us to step outside our comfort zone.

- **Acts 10:34-43** Then Peter replied, "I see very clearly that God shows no favoritism. 35 In every nation he accepts those who fear him and do what is right. 36 This is the message of Good News for the people of Israel—that there is peace with God through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all. 37 You know what happened throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee, after John began preaching his message of baptism. 38 And you know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

- 39 "And we apostles are witnesses of all he did throughout Judea and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a cross, 40 but God raised him to life on the third day. Then God allowed him to appear, 41 not to the general public, but to us whom God had chosen in advance to be his witnesses. We were those who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. 42 And he ordered us to preach everywhere and to testify that Jesus is the one appointed by God to be the judge of all—the living and the dead. 43 He is the one all the prophets testified about, saying that everyone who believes in him will have their sins forgiven through his name."

- Peter presents to them the gospel clearly!

- **John 14:6 Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.**

 - **Acts 4:10-12** Let me clearly state to all of you and to all the people of Israel that he was healed by the powerful name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, the man you crucified but whom God raised from the dead. 11 For Jesus is the one referred to in the Scriptures, where it says, 'The stone that you builders rejected has now become the cornerstone.' 12 **There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved."**

 - **Acts 10** Peter and Cornelius
 - **Acts 13** Paul and Barnabas at Antioch in Pisidia
