# Covenant King and “New” Covenant

- **2 Timothy 3:16-17** Every part of Scripture is God-breathed and useful one way or another — showing us truth, exposing our rebellion, correcting our mistakes, training us to live God's way. 17 Through the Word we are put together and shaped up for the tasks God has for us.

- **From Sinai to Joshua**
  - Joshua 24: 14-15; 19-20
  - But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord.“
- **To Judges**
  - **Judges 2:1-2** "I brought you out of Egypt into this land that I swore to give your ancestors, and I said I would never break my covenant with you. 2 For your part, you were not to make any covenants with the people living in this land; instead, you were to destroy their altars. But you disobeyed my command. Why did you do this?"

- vs. 10 After that generation died, another generation grew up who did not acknowledge the Lord or remember the mighty things he had done for Israel. NLT
- **Sin Cycle - Rebellion, Reaping, Repentance, Reviving, Restoration**
- What Went Wrong?
  - Judges 17:6 and 21:25
- God had gone to a great deal to deliver the peoples from Egypt, **Exodus 19:3-6**
- Somehow the author of Judges sums up the problem that they didn't have a king to lead them and tell them what to do!

## On to Samuel:

- **1 Samuel 8:4-5**

- Give us a king to judge us like all the other nations have."

- **1 Samuel 8:9** Do as they ask, but solemnly warn them about the way a king will reign over them."

- **1 Samuel 8:10-22**

- Samuel warns them

- The People refused to listen, even so give us a king!

- **Remember God's intent:** A People, A Place, His Presence!

## God chooses David - 1 Samuel 16:1

- 1 Samuel 16:7 But the Lord said to Samuel, "Don't judge by his appearance or height, for I have rejected him. **The Lord doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.**"
- **2 Samuel 7** – The Lord's Covenant with David
  - 10 And I will provide a homeland **for my people Israel, planting them in a secure place** where they will never be disturbed. Evil nations won't oppress them as they've done in the past,
  - 13 He is the one who will build **a house—a temple—for my name**. And I will secure his royal throne forever.
- The Lord has just added a 4<sup>th</sup> element to his Covenant of Grace:
  - His People, His Place, His Presence, **His King!**

## Everlasting Covenant

- **Ezekiel 16:59-61**"Now this is what the Sovereign Lord says: I will give you what you deserve, for **you have taken your solemn vows lightly by breaking your covenant.** 60 , and **I will establish an everlasting covenant with you. NLT**
- Jeremiah references a "New Covenant" Jeremiah 33:31; 33
- **People** - Ezekiel 36:8-12
- **Place** - Ezekiel 36:33-36
- **Presence** - Ezekiel 36:25-27
- **Covenant King** - Ezekiel 37:24-28 "My servant David will be their king, and they will have only one shepherd.
