**4 And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:**

**5 And as they were afraid, and bowed down their faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead?**

**6 He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee,**

## Remember His WORDS

**Remember...**

**When expectations are dashed, Luke 24: 2-3.**

**<sup>2</sup> And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulcher. <sup>3</sup> And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus.**

**When in worry, Luke 24:4, Matthew 6:34.**

**<sup>34</sup> Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.**

**When afraid of the unknown, Luke 24:5,  
Deut. 31:6. Isaiah 41:10**

**<sup>6</sup> Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.**

**Isaiah..., <sup>10</sup> Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.**



## Remember...,

**Psalms 78:42, They remembered not his hand, nor the day when he delivered them from the enemy.**

**Deut. 8:2, And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.**

### **Psalms 119:89-96**

**For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.**

**<sup>90</sup> Thy faithfulness is unto all generations: thou hast established the earth, and it abideth.**

**<sup>91</sup> They continue this day according to thine ordinances: for all are thy servants.**

**<sup>92</sup> Unless thy law had been my delights, I should then have perished in mine affliction.**

**<sup>93</sup> I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast quickened me.**

**<sup>94</sup> I am thine, save me: for I have sought thy precepts.**

**<sup>95</sup> The wicked have waited for me to destroy me: but I will consider thy testimonies.**

**<sup>96</sup> I have seen an end of all perfection: but thy commandment is exceeding broad.**



**Remember....,**

**Revelation 3:2-3**

**<sup>2</sup> Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.**

**<sup>3</sup> Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.**

**Heb 10:23 Remember God is Faithful**
