Seeding the Clouds

1 Kings 18:41-46

**You have to believe big and
pray bold prayers of faith.**

Seed the Clouds - **Sow today what you want to see tomorrow.**

- **1 Kings 16:29-17:1**

Identify the issue! - 1 Kings 18:16-19

Draw near to the Lord! - 1 Kings 18:30-33

Tomatis effect – The voice can only reproduce what the ear can hear!

- The root of the problem!
 - Hearing problem – it's ears that have been deafened to the still small voice of the Holy Spirit.
 - White noise of our Culture
 - Self talk problem – We are deafened by the sound of our own voice like the opera singer!
- **Cry out to the Lord!** - 1 Kings 18:36-39

1 Kings 18:41-46

Elijah hears something no one else is even listening for.

Those who don't hear the music, think the dancer is mad.

- **Humble, believing, prayer!**
 - James 4:6-8
 - Mark 9:20-24

Persistent Expectation

- Never accept your present position as final!

- Elijah asked his servant to go look for rain “seven times.”
 - Proverbs 24:16
 - The Israelites circle Jericho seven times on the seventh day in Joshua 6.
 - Naaman dips himself in the Jordan River seven times in II Kings 4.
 - Elijah prays for rain seven times in I Kings 18.
- Seeding the clouds is all about patient persistence. Consistency beats intensity seven days a week and twice on Sunday. You keep on keeping on!
 - Matthew 7:7-8
- Pray until something happens

Follow Through

- Seeing the cloud was the beginning of fulfillment!
- Tell Ahab it's coming! If you don't hurry the rain will stop!
- Supernatural ability – God's exclamation point!
- We think right here, right now.
God is thinking nations and generations.
We think that what God does for us is for us.
It's never just for us.
It's always for the third and fourth generation!
