▶ Dr. Peter Stoner did a study in mathematical probabilities. He knew from studying the Bible that Jesus Christ fulfilled over 330 prophecies of Scripture while He was on the earth.

▶ 8 Prophecies = 100000000000000000000000

▶ “100 Quadrillion

The Prophet Isaiah recorded 24 predictions about Him.

▶ Twenty-four, that all came true. –

1. Successful: Isaiah 52:13 – Revelation. 1:17-18
2. Disfigured: Isaiah 52:14 – Mark. 15:15
3. Reached nations & kings: Isaiah 52:15 – Acts 26:28
4. Grew up: Isaiah 53:2 – Luke 2:52
5. Despised & rejected: Isaiah 53:3 – Matthew. 26:65-67; 27:21-22
6. Bore our sickness: Isaiah 53:4a – Mark 1:32-34
7. Regarded Him as stricken: Isaiah 53:4b – John 19:15
8. Pierced: Isaiah 53:5 – John 19:32-34

9. Took our punishment: Isaiah 53:6 – Mark 15:34
10. Silent when oppressed: Isaiah 53:7a – Matthew 26:62-63
11. Like a lamb to slaughter: Isaiah 53:7b- Luke 23:26
12. Taken away: Isaiah 53:8a – John 19:16
13. Cut off from the living: Isaiah 53:8b – Ephesians 4:9
14. Rich man's grave: Isaiah 53:9 – John 19:38-42
15. Crushed by weight of sin: Isaiah 53:10a– Matthew 27:46
16. Guilt offering/never sinned: Isaiah 53:10b- Hebrews 4:15

17. Will see His seed: Isaiah 53:10c- Ephesians 4:8-10
18. Will prolong His days: Isaiah 53:10d- Acts 1:3
19. Will see the light: Isaiah 53:11a– Mark 16:16
20. Will justify many: Isaiah 53:11b- Romans 5:9
21. Given the many: Isaiah 53:12a- Revelation 7:9-10
22. Willingly submitted: Isaiah 53:12b- Luke 22:42
23. Counted among the rebels: Isaiah 53:12c- Mark 15:7-9
24. Interceded for rebels: Isaiah 53:12d- Luke 23:34, 42-43
