• **Greatest Commandment**

- Matthew 22:36-40 "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?"³⁷ Jesus replied, "'You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

- Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. - Romans 8:29-30 For those whom he foreknew **he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son**, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. 30 And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified. ESV

- Romans 12:1-2 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. 2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. ESV
- Romans 12:1-2 So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life — your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life — and **place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him.** 2 Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. **Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it.** Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you. We are members of one another

- Connected to one another, GK-allelon = a reciprocal and mutual work on the part of believers to one another.
- John 15:17 "This I command you, that you **love one another.**"
- Romans 12:10 **Be devoted to one another** in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor;
- Romans 12:16 **Be of the same mind toward one another**; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation.
- Romans 14:13 Therefore **let us not judge one another anymore**, but rather determine this not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way.
- Romans 15:5-7 Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to **be of the same mind with one another** according to Christ Jesus; 6 that with one accord you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. 7 Wherefore, **accept one another**, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.
- Romans 15:14 And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, and able also to **admonish one another.**

- 1 Corinthians 11:33 So then, my brethren, when you come together to eat, **wait for one another.**
- 1 Corinthians 12:25 that there should be no division in the body, but that the members should **have the same care for one another.**
- Galatians 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, **but through love serve one another.**
- Galatians 6:2 **Bear one another's burdens,** and thus fulfill the law of Christ.
- Ephesians 4:32 **And be kind to one another,** tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.
- Ephesians 5:19-21 **speaking to one another** in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; 20 always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father; 21 and be **subject to one another in the fear of Christ.**
- Philippians 2:3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind **let each of you regard one another as more important than himself;**
- Colossians 3:13 **bearing with one another, and forgiving each other,** whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.
- Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and **admonishing one another** with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

- Thessalonians 3:12 and may the Lord cause you to increase and **abound in love for one another**, and for all men, just as we also do for you;
- 1 Thessalonians 4:18 Therefore **comfort one another** with these words.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:13-15 **Live in peace with one another.** 14 And we urge you, brethren, admonish the unruly, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with all men. 15 See that no one repays another with evil for evil, **but always seek after that which is good for one another and for all men.**
- Hebrews 3:13-14 **But encourage one another day after day**, as long as it is still called "Today," lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.
- Hebrews 10:24-25 and **let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds**, 25 not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but **encouraging one another**; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.
- James 4:11 **Do not speak against one another**,
- James 5:16 Therefore, **confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another**, so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.
- 1 John 1:7-8 but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, **we have fellowship with one another**, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.
- 1 John 4:7-13 Beloved, **let us love one another**, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 8 The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. 9 By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. 10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 12 No one has beheld God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us.
