- **DEVOTED TO:**

- **DISCIPLESHIP** - Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. 19 **Therefore, go and make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. 20 **Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you.** And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." NLT

- **DISCIPLESHIP**, *noun* The state of a disciple or follower in doctrines and precepts.



- **Disciple** — a scholar, sometimes applied to the followers of John the Baptist (Matt 9:14), and of the Pharisees (22:16), but principally to the followers of Christ. A disciple of Christ is one who (1) **believes his doctrine**, (2) **rests on his sacrifice**, (3) **imbibes his spirit**, and (4) **imitates his example** (Matt 10:24; Luke 14:26,27,33; John 6:69). - **EFFECT'UAL**, *adjective* Producing an effect, or the effect desired or intended; **or having adequate power or force to produce the effect.** The means employed were *effectual*
- **Ephesians 3:7** Whereof I was made a minister, **according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.** KJV
- **Ephesians 4:16** From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, **according to the effectual working in the measure of every part,** maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love. KJV
- **Philemon 6** That the communication of thy faith **may become effectual** by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus. KJV
- **James 1:23-26** For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; 24 for once he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. 25 But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the law of liberty, and abides by it, **not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer,** this man shall be blessed in what he does. NASB
- **James 5:16** Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. **The effectual fervent prayer** of a righteous man availeth much. KJV

• VISION

- **Proverbs 29:18** Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint, but blessed is he who keeps the law. ESV
- **Proverbs 29:18** Where there is no word from God, people are uncontrolled, but those who obey what they have been taught are happy. NCV
- **Proverbs 29:18** If people can't see what God is doing, they stumble all over themselves; But when they attend to what he reveals, they are most blessed. MSG
- Where (there is) no vision, the people perish. Where there is no setting forth of the will of God, whether by special revelation, as in old times (Ps 74:9; Lam 2:9; Ezek 7:26), or by the ordinary ministrations of God's ministers and God's Word, as now, "the people perish." The Hebrew verb [yipaara±] means 'are dissipated;' also 'revolt,' 'become unbridled,' and so perish. To this unbridled, and consequently ruinous state, is opposed in the parallel clause, "happy;" as "the law" stands in contrast to "no vision." Such did the Jews become, instead of their former happy state, when they rejected the Word of the Lord; and consequently lost their kingdom and place. • TRAINED

- **Matthew 13:52** He said, "Then you see how every student well-trained in God's kingdom is like the owner of a general store who can put his hands on anything you need, old or new, exactly when you need it." MSG
- **Luke 6:39-41** He also told them a parable: "Can a blind man lead a blind man? Will they not both fall into a pit? 40 A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained will be like his teacher. ESV
- **1 Timothy 4:6-9** If you put these things before the brothers, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, being trained in the words of the faith and of the good doctrine that you have followed. 7 Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness; 8 for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come. ESV
- **Hebrews 5:11-14** About this we have much to say, and it is hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing. 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God. You need milk, not solid food, 13 for everyone who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, since he is a child. 14 But solid food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil. ESV
- **Hebrews 12:11** For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. ESV

- **ENLARGEMENT**, *noun* Increase of size or bulk, real or apparent; extension of dimensions or limits; augmentation; dilatation; expansion. The *enlargement* of bulk may be by accretion or addition; of dimensions, by spreading, or by additions to length and breadth; of a sum or amount, by addition, collection or accumulation.
- **1. Expansion or extension, applied to the mind, to knowledge, or to the intellectual powers, by which the mind comprehends a wider range of ideas or thought.**
- **2. Expansion of the heart, by which it becomes more benevolent and charitable.**
- **3. Release from confinement, servitude, distress or straits. [Esther 4:14](#).**
- **Isaiah 54:2-3** "Enlarge the place of your tent, and let the curtains of your habitations be stretched out; do not hold back; lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes.
3 For you will spread abroad to the right and to the left, and your offspring will possess the nations and will people the desolate cities. ESV

- **DEVOTED**

- Acts 2:42-47 And **they devoted themselves** to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. 43 And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. 44 And all who believed were together and had all things in common. 45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. 46 And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved. ESV
