Isaiah 41:15-16

¹⁶ You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, And the whirlwind shall scatter them; You shall rejoice in the LORD, *And* glory in the Holy One of Israel.



It's being Restored

Joel 2:25-27

25 “So I will restore to you the years that the swarming [k]locust has eaten,

The crawling locust,

The consuming locust,

And the chewing locust,

My great army which I sent among you.

26 You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied,

And praise the name of the Lord your God,

Who has dealt wondrously with you;

And My people shall never be put to shame.

It's being **Revived**

Psalms 85:6 - Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?

Psalms 80:19 - Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.

Isaiah 57:15 - For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabited eternity, whose name [is] Holy; I dwell in the high and holy [place], with him also [that is] of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.
